Instructions for setting V-Rod Model clocks

SETTING THE CLOCK: 2005 and 2006 VRSCSE (No 12/24 hour clock option) Clock set button is located just aft of the horn below the left side frame rail.

- 1. Turn the ignition switch ON.
- 2. Press and hold the clock-set button for five seconds until the last digit of the minutes display on the clock begins to blink. Release the button.
- Press and release the clock-set button repeatedly to advance the last digit of the minutes display. Each time you press and release the button, the display will advance one minute.
- When the correct minute is displayed, press and hold the clock-set button for five seconds, the minutes display will switch to the first digit of the minutes display.
- 5. Press and release the clock-set button repeatedly to advance the first digit of the minutes display. Each time you press and release the button, the display will advance one minute.
- 6. When the correct minute is displayed, press and hold the clock-set button for five seconds, the minutes display will switch to the hours display (both digits).
- Press and release the clock-set button repeatedly to advance the hours display. Each time you press and release the button, the display will advance one hour.
- 8. When the correct hour is displayed, press and hold the clock-set button for five seconds, then release. The hours display will stop blinking, indicating that the clock has been set.
- 9. Turn the ignition switch OFF.

SETTING THE CLOCK: 2006 VRSCA, VRSCD, 2006 VRSCR

Post 2006 model launch

First launch of 2006 VRSCR (2005.5) model does not have clock feature **Has 12/24 hour clock option.**

Clock set button is the same button used to re-set odometer and change odometer modes.

- 1. Turn the ignition switch ON.
- 2. Press and hold the clock-set button for five seconds until 12HR on the clock begins to blink. Release the button.
- Press and release the clock-set button one time to advance to 24HR or military style time display. Each time you press and release the button, the display will switch between 12HR and 24HR.
- 4. When the desired style is displayed, press and hold the clock-set button for five seconds, the display will switch to the hours display.
- 5. Press and release the clock-set button repeatedly to advance the hours. Each time you press and release the button, the display will advance one hour.
- 6. When the correct hour is displayed, press and hold the clock-set button for five seconds, the hours display will switch to the minutes display.
- 7. Press and release the clock-set button repeatedly to advance the minutes display. Each time you press and release the button, the display will advance one minute.
- 8. When the correct minutes are displayed, press and hold the clock-set button for five seconds, then release. The minutes display will stop blinking, indicating that the clock has been set.
- 9. Turn the ignition switch OFF.
