A small solid dish shaped disc which is used to seal the hole in a case where it's been drilled, etc. 2)

## **Wet Liner**

A liquid cooled engine design where the pistons run in liners that are surrounded by engine coolant 3)

## **Wet Sumping**

AKA Sumping. A condition in which the engine oil collects in the bottom of the engine, or oil filter instead of being returned to the tank  $^4$

The distance from the center of the front wheel to the center of the rear wheel

# **Woodruff Key**

A half moon shaped or square key set into a slot on a shaft used to keep a slotted gear from turning.

#### **Wrist Pin**

Gudgeon pin or piston pin <sup>5)</sup> Holds the piston onto the connecting rod.
